





### Qur'an

### Hadith

Sahih Bukhari - Narrated by Aisha, (the wife of the Prophet)
Hamza bin Amr Al Aslami asked the Prophet, "Should I fast while travelling?"
The Prophet replied, "You may fast if you wish and you may not fast if you wish."

### To be done with the help of an Adult

### **INGREDIENTS**

- · 3 cups | 750g long grain parboiled rice
- · Tomato Stew
- · Meat /Chicken
- · Pepper and salt (to taste)
- · 2 medium onions
- · 3 Knorr cubes
- · 2 teaspoons thyme

### BEFORE YOU COOK JOLLOF RICE

- 1. Prepare the tomato stew.
- 2. If you will use whole chicken then wash and cut it into pieces. Cook with the thyme, Knorr cubes and 2 bulbs of onions (chopped). The cooking time depends on the type of chicken. When done, grill it in an oven or also fry it. This is to give it a golden look which is more presentable especially if you have guests for dinner.
- 3. Parboil the rice. Rinse the parboiled rice and put in a sieve to drain.

### **COOKING DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Pour the chicken stock and the tomato stew into a sizeable pot and leave to boil.
- 2. Add the drained parboiled rice, salt and pepper to taste. The water level should be the same level of the rice. This is to ensure that all the water dries up by the time the rice is cooked.
- Cover the pot and leave to cook on low to medium heat. This way the rice does not burn before the water dries up.
   The rice should be done by the time the water is dry. Taste to confirm.
   If not, you will need to add more water and reduce the heat to prevent burning. Keep cooking till done.

Serve with Fried Plantain, Moi Moi, Salad or Coleslaw.




### **All about Dates**

Children love dates! In sha Allah we will do some activities and also learn interesting facts about dates.





Only Allah knows when the Night of Qadr is. But the Messenger of Allah has told us to seek for it during the odd nights on the last IO nights of Ramadan.







### **Zakaatul Fitr**

Zakaatul Fitr is a form of charity that every Muslim who is able to, must give to the poor and needy at the end of Ramadan and before Eid Salaah.

Allah's Messenger enjoined the payment of one Saa' of dates or one Saa' of barley as Zakat-ul-fitr on every Muslim slave or free, male or female, young or old, and he ordered that it be paid before the people went out to offer the Eid prayer.

(Saheeh Al Bukhaari Hadeeth Number 1418)



One saa' consists of four amdadd (plural of mudd). A Mudd is equal to one handful Using two hands cupped together of an average size man.
